






























## Project Description


- Construct One (1) new booster station
  - Mission Inn
- Abandon Two (2) existing booster stations
  - Mary Evans
  - Rubidoux
- Construct new 8 and 12-inch water pipelines
- Replace aged and undersized pipelines
- Consolidate two small pressure zones



## Project Benefits

- Improved fire flow
- Improved water service reliability
- Improved water pressure to facilitate irrigation of Loring Park
- Improved water pressure for some residents





# Aesthetics Are Important

- Building Design to blend with current surroundings
- Block wall façade will be near match to historic walls on Mt. Rubidoux Drive
- Two (2) old Carob Trees to be removed
- Two (2) new trees to be planted
- New landscaping will screen facilities












# Project Timeline
