APPLICANT: City of Riverside

LOCATION: The Project area is located within the existing public street right-of-ways of Loring Park, Mt. Rubidoux Drive, Mission Inn Avenue, Redwood Drive, 9th Street, Allis Place, Glenwood Drive, and Miramonte Place within the City of Riverside.

PROPOSAL: The City of Riverside, through its Public Utilities Department (RPU), is proposing construction of a new water booster station within the Mt. Rubidoux Drive right-of-way at Loring Park and new or replacement subterranean pipelines within aforementioned public street right-of-ways. Furthermore, the proposed Project includes the abandonment and demolition of the existing Rubidoux and Mary Evans booster stations and the consolidation of three existing water pressure zones into one. The proposed Project will take place in order to address the issues of low water pressure, insufficient fire flow, booster station operation deficiencies and aged and existing undersized water mains.


